GET VACCINATED





•The flu vaccine is free for people with respiratory conditions.



ASTHMA MANAGEMENT

- ·Have an up-to-date asthma management plan.
- ·A plan helps identify what to do when well, unwell or need help in an emergency.



MEDICATION

- ·Make sure inhalers aren't empty or out of date.
- ·Take medication as prescribed and use a spacer if your inhaler allows it.



- ·Ensure children always carry medication in their school backpack.

·Check technique with a doctor or nurse.



TALK TO YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER

- ·Make sure your child will tell a teacher if feeling unwell.
- •Give teacher copy of asthma management plan.
- ·Make sure school has your emergency contact details.



KNOW YOUR TRIGGERS

Triggers can be:



- ·Stress and/or anxiety ·Change of environment ·Allergens in classrooms
- ·Mould spores
- ·Dust
- ·Cleaning products.





- ·Wash hands with soap.
- Provide hand sanitizer.
- ·Teach kids 'germ etiquette'.
