

FIRST AMENDMENT

TO

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

This First Amendment ("Amendment") to the Memorandum of Agreement for Professional Services is made by and between Trenton Medical Center, Inc., d/b/a Palms Medical Group, ("PALMS") and the Suwanee County School Board, ("SCSB") on this 8th day of August, 2023.

RECITALS

PALMS currently provides certain primary care and wellness services to SCSB pursuant to that Agreement between the parties with a term of August 9, 2022 to August 8, 2025.

The parties wish to amend certain sections of the Agreement between the parties with such Amendment becoming part of the Agreement.

For good and valuable consideration including, but not limited to, the continued provision of services, the parties agree as follows:

1. This First Amendment applies to the following specifically identified sections of the Agreement. Unless specifically stated otherwise, all sections of the Agreement not specifically addressed shall remain unchanged and in full effect. This First Amendment shall become effective when signed by both parties.
2. Exhibit A of the Agreement is amended to add the following additional services:
 - a. PALMS will make its pharmacy located at 211 Ranchera Street, Live Oak and 103 SW US Hwy 27, Branford available to individuals being served under the Agreement. The pharmacy shall fill and dispense, subject to its formulary, lawful prescriptions issued by PALMS providers providing services under the Agreement.
 - b. PALMS will collect a fee from each patient receiving a prescription as required under SCSD's self-insured health plan. PALMS will bill SCSB a separate fee for the filled prescription.
3. SCSB shall compensate the PALMS for its cost of any drugs dispensed plus a dispensing fee per prescription. Such compensation shall be made within 10 days of invoicing by PALMS.
