

## All Suwannee County Schools:

To be eligible for Kindergarten,

### your Child must turn 5 years old on or before September 1, 2022.

If your child is a current VPK student and will be returning next year for KG, you do not need to re-apply for enrollment.

Our enrollment process is now paperless. Before applying for enrollment for your child, you will need to login to your FOCUS Parent Portal Account at https://focus.suwannee.k12.fl.us.

If you do not have a Parent Portal account, click the link to register for an account (or to reset your password).

On the parent portal, click the appropriate option:

If your student has never attended any SCSD School, choose the first option.

If your student has attended an SCSD School and your parent account already has access to the student, choose the second option.

If your student has attended an SCSD School and your parent account DOES NOT have access to the student, choose the third option. You will need your child's student ID number and your child's most recent school will have to approve your access before you may proceed. Once this process is complete, log back into FOCUS and choose the second option.

# Florida VPK REGISTRATION 2022-2023

## All Suwannee County Schools:

The Voluntary Prekindergarten Program – or VPK – is a free pre-kindergarten program for 4 and 5-year-olds who reside in Florida and were born on or before September 1 of each program year.

To be eligible for VPK, you must obtain a <u>certificate from <u>http://www.floridaearlylearning.com</u> in order to attend Suwannee County School District.</u>

#### **New students**

- Once you receive a <u>certificate</u> from the Division of Early Learning, complete an online application for Suwannee County School District. Students zoned for Live Oak schools must make a school selection during the application process.
  - Returning students
- If your child is currently enrolled in a Suwannee County school as a PK student and will be returning next year for VPK, you do not need to re-apply for enrollment. Once you receive the <u>certificate</u> turn it in to your child's registrar at the school.
